# Black student enrollment increases by 400

Black student enrollment at the U-M Ann Arbor campus has increased by some 400 this year over last year, according to a report made to the Regents at their December meeting.

A survey of students at the Fall 1971 registration period indicated 1,708 black students, almost exactly the number projected as an interim goal. A similar survey at the Fall 1972 registration, in which students are asked to identify themselves as to race or minority group, indicated 2,105 black students.

Some 3,000 students did not identify themselves by race or minority group. A percentage of the unidentified equal to the proportion of identified black students in the total student body would produce another 200 black students, or a total black enrollment of 2,305.

But that still is about 100 students below the projection.

The "loss" of 284 black students who graduated in 1971-72 was anticipated. But the admission of 1,139 new black students produced only 889 new enrollments—294 accepted for graduate and graduate-professional work did not enroll. Attrition of black students enrolled last year was greater than expected.

Among Opportunity Program undergraduates (85 per cent of whom are black), for example, while seven per cent graduated, another 20 per cent who were enrolled last year and did not graduate failed to return.

"Of that 20 per cent, half were in good academic standing," said William L. Cash, Jr., assistant to
