More than half Ann Arbor students receive aid

Students at the Ann Arbor campus received \$23,286,265 in outright grants and scholarship assistance during 1974-75, the Board of Regents was told in December by Richard A. English, associate vice president for academic affairs.

In addition, \$6,653,798 in loans were made by the University and students earned \$16,952,539 through various campus employment opportunities.

"This support to students totals \$46,892,602," English said. "Analysis of this report's data indicates that 58 per cent or 19,054 of the students on the Ann Arbor campus received some form of assistance last year—salaries and wages were paid to 33.5 per cent of the students, 40.6 per cent received scholarships or grants, and 16.9 per cent obtained loans. Some received assistance from more than one of these types of support.

"Looked at another way, if the \$46,892,602 total student assistance had been spread across the entire student body, it would cover 32.1 per cent of the estimated \$146,000,000 it costs students here each year for tuition, books, room, board and personal expenses."

Figures in the report differ somewhat from the previously-published 1974-75 Financial Report, which also included assis-

"This appears to be a reflection of the fact that Michigan and other universities are attempting to expand the enrollment of persons than 80 per cent of the minority

from lower income families. At Michigan, most minority students tend to come from families with lower median incomes than those of other students.

"Therefore, while blacks, Native Americans, and Spanish surnamed persons comprised 8.4 per cent of the total number of enrolled students (those included in the report), they received 20.2 per cent of the total support. More than 80 per cent of the minority

students, except for Asian Americans, received some form of support."

English also compared financial support for women and men. Nearly the same percentages (58.3 per cent of the women and 57.8 per cent of the men) received assistance.
