In any event," Shapiro cites "our current lack of information on the relevant regional and national situations" as a "major difficulty."

"To what extent, for example,

is the pool of qualified applicants changing, or in what way is the competition for these students changing? Answers to these and other questions would affect both our goals and our policies."

The Academic Affairs report

also includes a review of minority student recruitment centrally and within the schools and colleges, in which "involvement by minority faculty members" is said to be "one of the more effective" approaches.

Some problems, exaggerated — "Minority and non-minority undergraduate students share the same set of problems related to their enrollment and completion of their studies," Shapiro points out. "However it appears that

minority students often have these problems in exaggerated terms. "As the institution learns more about attrition and persistence," he concludes, "we will be better able to serve both groups of students."

Eleven schools and colleges encountered declines in total enrollment over the past year, and all 11 reported reductions in minority registrations as well. Of the six schools and colleges where total enrollment increased, four of them—Architecture and Urban Planning, Business Administration, Engineering and Law—also reported

increased numbers of minority students. The report, compiled by the Office of Academic Affairs, reveals the "most severe" minority enrollment decline at the graduate level, "exactly where our overall enrollments have been weakest."

Black student population shows biggest decline

Minority enrollment dips below 10 per cent mark

Minority enrollment is down — below 10 per cent — on the Ann Arbor campus, according to the most recent figures compiled by the Office of Academic Affairs. At Flint and Dearborn, there were modest increases.

In a report slated for public discussion at Thursday afternoon's meeting of the Board of Regents (3:30 p.m.), Harold Shapiro, vice resident for academic affairs, profiles enrollments at all three campuses for fall 1976 and fall 1977.

9.5% in Ann Arbor —

On the Ann Arbor campus last fall, 3,204 of a 33,801 total student enrollment were Black or of Asian American. Native American or Spanish surnamed American heritage... 9.5 per cent of the overall enrollment.

A year earlier, during fall 1976, the minority proportion was 3,425 out of 33,871 students, or 10.1 per cent. Although all minority groups of Asian Americans declined in the largest "contraction," according to the report, was among Black students; a year ago, 241 students made up 7.2 per cent of the total Ann Arbor student body; in fall 1977, the percentage fell to 1.1 per cent. On the Dearborn campus,

minority enrollment increased by 11 students—365 to 376—over the past year, the percentage of total enrollment declining slightly, however, from 6.9 per cent in fall 1976 to 6.8 per cent last fall.

While minority enrollment rose slightly in Flint (from 524 to 531 students), minority enrollment as a per cent of the total student body also declined—from 14.2 per cent in fall 1976 to 14.0 per cent in fall 1977.

Why a decline? —

The overall decline in minority students on the Ann Arbor campus was "most severe among new transfer students and Rackham continuing students," the report points out, "since the number of new freshmen and cross-campus transfers increased slightly."

Some of the enrollment decline can be explained by an increase in the number of degrees granted to minority students (from 987 to 1,047), Shapiro notes. However, "There still remains a sizeable portion" of the decline in continuing students (from 2,437 in fall 1976 to 2,298 last semester) "which must be accounted for by other means."

Among those "other means" are recruitment and "retention/attribution," areas Shapiro says merit-

and will receive further study from U-M administrators.

"At present we have a proposal before the U.S. Office of Education that, if funded, will allow us to provide improved academic services to opportunity students," Shapiro says in the report to Regents.

"We are also designing a study of the causes of attrition among minority students—in a joint effort with the Universities of Illinois-Champaign-Urbana and Wisconsin-Madison.

"In the interim, however, we shall try to establish, using more informal channels, some of the reasons for this attrition and how our situation compares with that in other universities." Richard English, associate vice president for academic affairs, notes that telephone interviews are planned with as many former minority students as possible—continuing students who "dropped out" before completing a U-M degree program.

Shapiro adds that consultations already begun with schools, colleges and academic service offices also are focusing on financial aid—"which did not keep pace with inflation last year"—and "external factors such as national

trends, availability assessment and competition."

Competition increasing —

"The University was one of the first major research institutions to make a substantial commitment to affirmative action in student enrollment," Shapiro says. "Now the

competition for these students appears to be increasing at all levels.

"An additional factor is that the pool of in-state minority applicants may no longer be able to significantly contribute to minority enrollment increases."
