University efforts to recruit and graduate larger numbers of minority and other disadvantaged students have met with "uneven success" over the past several years, officials concede in a report to be presented to the Regents Thursday.

The annual minority student enrollment report, prepared by the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, shows an increase of only 40 minority students over last fall on all three campuses — from 9.3 per cent of the total student population in fall, 1977, to 9.5 per cent in fall, 1978. On the Ann Arbor campus, the percentage of minority students has dropped from 9.5 per cent (1977) to 9.3 per cent (3,204 students in 1977; 3,129

in 1978, out of a total student enrollment of 33,622). Dearborn registered the biggest gain in minority students — 100, or 8 per cent; Flint reported 15 additional minority students, totalling 13.9 per cent of its enrollment.

Attrition a problem, too — The report also illustrates a related problem: attrition. An analysis of the class of 1979, which four years ago included 4,941 freshmen and 1,795 transfers, shows a "disenrollment" rate of 68 per cent for Native Americans; 46.3 per cent, Hispanic Americans; 42.7 per cent, Black Americans; 26 per cent, White Americans; and 25.9 per cent, Asian Americans.

notes Harold Shapiro, vice president for academic affairs — especially at the graduate level. "A recent report by Stanford University shows the same sort of thing. And our problem is not as great as that of many other schools in the Big Ten." Minority applications also are down in Law and Medicine, a trend apparent in other universities as well.

projects already under way. The Prospective Scholars Program, for example, should "enable us to pick up more high quality students both in-state and out-of-state." University officials are also hopeful that the "Each One-Reach One" program will result in increased numbers of qualified students. The new plan asks current minority students to identify and refer to the office of Undergraduate Admissions at least one person who might qualify for enrollment at the U-M. Other efforts to increase minority enrollment at the undergraduate level include heavier participation by minority counselors in recruiting in those geographic areas with high concentrations of minority students.

The Minority Visitation plan focuses on bringing minority students in the biological, physical and analytical social sciences to campus, while Graduate and Professional Opportunities provides fellowships for graduate programs in health-related fields and the analytical social sciences. The CIC Program in Social Sciences, funded by the Lilly Endowment, Inc., awards two-year fellowships. Several schools and colleges also have their own programs.

In the area of retention, several new efforts in the schools and colleges are outlined along with two academic counseling programs begun this fall for entering freshmen.

The programs — one offered by USA and the other by the Opportunity
