Executive Summary
Report on Minority Recruitment, Enrollment,
Retention, and Graduation
Fall, 1980

Total Minority Enrollment - All Campuses

Minority enrollment decreased by about one percent from its 1978 and 1979 levels to 4,424 students in Fall 1980. Minority students now represent 9.4 of the total enrollment on all campuses, compared to 9.6 percent in 1978 and 1979. However, the decrease in minority enrollment was not evenly distributed by campus, with the number of minority students on the Ann Arbor campus decreasing in Fall 1979 and Fall 1980. Both Flint and Dearborn report increases in minority enrollment since Fall 1978.

Minority Enrollment in Degree Programs - Ann Arbor

Minority enrollment in on-campus degree credit programs decreased by 1.5 percent between Fall 1978 and Fall 1979 and by 2.4 percent between Fall 1979 and Fall 1980. Black enrollment decreased by 10.5 percent between 1978 and 1979, and continued to fall between 1979 and 1980, although at a slightly lower rate (8.5 percent). Conversely, the number of Asian students is continuing to grow.

School and College Minority Enrollment in Degree Programs - Ann Arbor

Changes in minority enrollment were not evenly distributed over schools and colleges. At the undergraduate level, Black enrollment decreased in six units between 1979 and 1980 with most of these reductions being in units which had overall enrollment declines during this period: Education, Nursing, Pharmacy, Architecture, and Natural Resources.

Much of the decrease in minority enrollment in Rackham was due to a decline in Black enrollment between Fall 1979 and Fall 1980. Total enrollment and Black enrollment fell most sharply in the School of Education.

Applications and Admissions Offers for Degree Programs - Ann Arbor

Applications and admissions offers associated with minority students increased between Fall 1979 and Fall 1980. Enrollment of new minority students at the undergraduate and non-Rackham graduate and professional levels also increased. At the undergraduate level, applications and admissions offers associated with Black students decreased between 1979 and 1980, although new enrollment by Black students stayed about the same (264 in 1979 and 262 in 1980). However, the SAT scores of entering Black undergraduates have shown steady improvement since 1978.

Enrollment Comparisons with Selected Universities - Ann Arbor

Despite decreases in minority enrollment, The University of Michigan continues to have the second highest percentage of minority students in the Big 10, after Northwestern University.

Degree Credit Enrollment by Race and Sex - Ann Arbor

In Fall 1980, women represented 44.6 percent of the students in degree programs. Among Black students, however, women accounted for 60.5 percent of the Black undergraduate enrollment and 57.7 percent of the Black enrollment in Rackham.

Degrees Granted - Ann Arbor

Minority students received 10.1 percent of the degrees granted between 1976-77 and 1979-80, including 13.3 percent of the doctoral degrees.

Degrees received by Asian and American Indian students have increased absolutely and relatively since 1976-77. For Hispanics and Black students the reverse has been true. Although degrees received by Black students have stayed at 6.2 percent of the total degrees for the two most recent years, the number of degrees received by Blacks has fallen from 743 in 1976-77 to 577 in 1979-80. This represents a decrease of 22.3 percent, compared to a decrease of 4.8 percent in degrees received by all students.

Undergraduate Student Withdrawal/Retention/Graduation - Ann Arbor

Black, Hispanic, and American Indian students continue to have the highest rates of withdrawal from the University, but the gap between these students and others appears to be narrowing. For example, students in the above minority groups entering in Fall 1975 were about 50 percent more likely than other students to withdraw before graduation. While the withdrawal rate for minority students entering in Fall 1978 and 1979 was higher than for other students, the withdrawal rates of minority and non-minority students are more similar than in the past.

Student Recruitment and Retention Programs - Ann Arbor

Several schools and colleges have developed, or are in the process of developing, comprehensive recruitment and retention programs. One example is the College of Engineering which participates actively in pre-college enrichment programs and provides special follow-up for students if they enroll at the University.

Among other efforts seen as effective are programs that monitor student progress during each term and provide students with needed assistance at the most appropriate time. Examples of programs such as these are found in the Law School, the Opportunity Program, and the Medical School.

Special outreach efforts to present or prospective minority students with distinguished academic records are noted in several areas. An ad hoc faculty group is initiating a new educational effort with Renaissance High School in Detroit: a school that draws outstanding students from all parts of the city. Further, the LSA Honors Program is bringing more outstanding minority students, especially Opportunity students, into the program.

In an effort to parallel the outreach services being offered to Opportunity students by the Opportunity Program, CULS and LSA Counseling have begun to provide special outreach services for minority students not enrolled in the Opportunity Program. Further, the Mathematics Laboratory in LSA is a significant response

to problems in introductory mathematics experienced by minority and non-minority students.

Toward More Effective Programs

Some of the possible ways to improve minority recruitment and retention are noted in Section VI and include the following: expansion of pre-college enrichment programs, more effective coordination of graduate and professional recruitment, increasing efforts to monitor student progress during each term, and more effective coordination of services for minority students.

Table 10 shows the status of the Fall 1975 and Fall 1976 freshman classes four years after their original enrollment at the University. Slightly over 49 percent of the Fall 1975 freshman class had received a degree by September 1979. By September 1980, 45.7 percent of the Fall 1976 freshman class had received a degree. Black, American Indian, and Hispanic students were less likely than Asian and white students to have graduated after four years.

Approximately 20 percent of the students in each class had not received degrees after four years and were still enrolled at the University. Most of the students who were still enrolled had accumulated 85 or more credit hours and were therefore within one year of attaining sufficient credit hours for graduation.

The percentage of degree recipients in the class of Fall 1975 increased after five years to 56.4 percent as of September 1980. As can be seen from the following figures, the increases for Black, American Indian, and Hispanic students were somewhat larger than for other racial/ethnic groups. Between three and four percent of the class of 1975 were still enrolled in Fall 1980 and had accumulated 85 or more credits toward a degree.

Tables 11 through 13 provide additional information on select minority students having the highest attrition rates: Blacks, American Indian, and Hispanic students.

Table 11 includes freshmen who have not received degrees and are no longer enrolled, and indicates how many years they were enrolled. Information on five freshman classes is included in the Table.

Between twenty-five and thirty percent of the select minority students have withdrawn during the first two years of their enrollment compared to about twenty percent of students in other racial/ethnic groups. Some improvement can be noted in the withdrawal rate of select minority students within the first year of enrollment between the first three freshman classes in the Table (1975, 1976, 1977) and the 1978 and 1979 freshman classes. It should also be noted that the withdrawal percentages (in the "total" column) are becoming more similar for the select minority students and all other students.
