## for black students at U-M

"WHEN I first got here, the Bursley family organized a welcoming committee," says Yvette DuBois, a freshman from Gary, Ind. "I made a lot of new friends. It was like a backbone, something to rest up against. It gives you a group of people to identify with as soon as you get here."

In addition to helping students adjust and survive once they arrive on U-M's competitive campus, the Family helps recruit more black students.

About six years ago, the Family started inviting black high school seniors to visit U-M. The program has

grown and now, with financial help from the university, it draws about 100 potential students to Ann Arbor each year.

For four days the high schoolers stay with older black students, attend their classes, go to their parties and tour the campus. The upperclassmen say they are honest with the recruits about UM's opportunities, as well as problems with racism and segregation.

In the end, Family members say, almost all of the high school students end up attending the university and many join the Bursley Family.

They are at the University of Michigan. In a 1980 survey by the U-M Center for Afro-American Studies, 85 percent of the school's blacks said they felt racial discrimination on campus and 46 percent said they did not feel any ties to U-

The recently published "Black Student's Guide to Colleges," described racial relations at the Ann Arbor campus as "the pits," and cited "unnecessary tension" between students and black faculty.

The guide's researchers admittedly interviewed just a handful of black students on each campus. No other Michigan school was included among the 113 rated.

U-M students say racial relations have worsened since the trial last summer of Leo Kelly, a black student convicted of murdering two white fellow

dorm residents. Kelly, who is serving a double life sentence, pleaded not guilty by reason of insanity. He argued that racism and isolation at college forced him to lose control and shoot the two students in a psychotic rage.

At U-M, where one of every 21 students is black, "you walk around this campus and feel you're not wanted," says Haugabook, a graduate of Central High in Detroit. "In my freshman year, I was the only black in my dorm, and I would try to mix and mingle. I would go down the hall, and half the dorm would be in a room with the door open . . . talking and laughing. I would try to mix and meet people, and conversation ceased. All the white students would get uptight."

Back in 1970, U-M regents set a goal of 10 percent black enrollment for the school. Black enrollment peaked in 1976

at seven percent; since then it has fallen steadily to its current 4.7 percent.

Officials at the colleges offer few suggestions on turning around the decline in black enrollment. But some are trying.

THE UNIVERSITY of Detroit recently started holding workshops around the city to teach low-income parents how to best apply for financial aid for their children. Response to the workshops has been overwhelming, according to U-D Admissions Director Jim Masuga.

MSU's Green says schools must bring in more black professors if they hope to recruit more black students. "Think about if a white student went into a school and all his teachers were black," says Green. "He would be pretty uncomfortable. Well, it's the same for many black students now."

At MSU, only 3.6 percent of the faculty and 5.8 percent of the students are black. At Wayne State, by contrast, 9.1 percent of the faculty are black, as are 22.5 percent of the students.

Finally, the state task force report suggested that colleges work more closely with urban high schools to recruit and better prepare black students for college.

University administrators admit their current recruitment efforts have failed and admit campus race relations are often poor.

"It's a problem we're cognizant of," says Vice-President Johnson. "We need to work on it, but you must realize the problem starts long before the student gets here. Racism permeates society."

Will you please reschedule our meeting with you for any day after July 18, 1983, and place the Michigan State Conference of Branches on your Board of Regents' agenda for the next meeting following our meeting.

As a major public university The University of Michigan has a special responsibility to provide enhanced educational access to qualified students of all races. Further, as a matter of social justice and institutional excellence, we are committed to broadening the representation of minority students since the quality of the University is enhanced by a diverse student body. In view of these and other considerations, the University created a new senior position, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, to which Professor Niara Sudarkasa was appointed in early 1984. A major responsibility of this position is to analyze our current programs to recruit and retain minority students and to recommend the development of new programs that would move us closer to our goals.

The first phase of Associate Vice President Sudarkasa's work has been focused on undergraduate recruitment and financial aid programs, and is the subject of the attached summary report. Subsequent efforts will address additional issues such as retention and graduate student enrollments.

Based upon Dr. Sudarkasa's study and analysis of the main issues related to undergraduate recruitment and financial aid, recommendations have been developed and a phased implementation of them initiated. Major improvements in the first phase of implementation include increased financial aid and increased staffing and budgetary support for the offices of Admissions and Financial Aid. Assuming that we succeed in our efforts to attract more minority students, the initial costs in financial aid programs will be \$230,000 in 1985-86, building to \$1,440,000 annually over the following five years. The first phase of the implementation plan will focus resources primarily on in-state underrepresented minorities, with the objective of increasing underrepresented minority students by as much as 100 percent over current levels. The plan has the following components:

- Enhancement of the existing Michigan Achievement Award (MAA) program. The number of MAA merit awards that will be available to entering in-state students will be increased and the size of individual awards will be increased from the current level of \$750 to \$1000. These awards for entering in-state students will be renewable in subsequent years based on financial need.
- Increase in the number of Opportunity awards. Financial aid funds will be increased to accommodate an increase in the number of in-state Opportunity students, and to provide improved need-based financial aid packages to entering in-state students who are not MAA recipients and who are not in the Opportunity Program.
- Funding for out-of-state MAA awards. A source of funding has been identified that will enable the University to continue offering out-of-state MAA awards of \$2,500, which are renewable based on need, to outstanding entering underrepresented minority students.

In addition to these programs, the first phase of implementation includes funds for personnel and other administrative costs in 1985-86 and subsequent years which is designed to enable the University to provide more personalized recruiting and supportive services to students, high school counselors, teachers, and principals, as well as parents and others.

Background

One of my charges when I assumed my present role as Associate Vice President was to assess on-going efforts related to minority student enrollment and retention and to recommend new initiatives that might move the University toward its goal of increasing that enrollment. Pursuant to this, last Winter term, I met with the Vice President and staff of Student Services, each of the Deans of the 17 schools and colleges, the Directors of Admissions, Financial Aid, Orientation, Housing, the Comprehensive Studies/Opportunity Program, and LSA Academic Counseling; and talked to minority faculty, staff and students for the purpose of obtaining information as well as gleaning their perspectives on some of the problems and prospects in the area of minority student recruitment and retention.

In November, 1984 I presented to the Executive Officers the first of what will be a series of three discussion papers containing recommendations regarding undergraduate and graduate minority enrollment at the University. The first paper focused on undergraduate recruitment, admissions, and financial aid, because policies in these areas alone can make or break any effort to increase the number of minority students at Michigan. The paper reflected my judgment concerning the key issues that must be confronted if we are to increase the enrollment of underrepresented minorities on this campus. The purpose of the paper and the present summary is to highlight some of the policies and practices regarding admissions and financial aid that have affected and will continue to impact upon our efforts on behalf of the University's commitment, made in 1970, to a goal of increasing minority enrollment generally, and of increasing Black enrollment to a level of ten percent.

Economic factors have contributed to the enrollment decline in other ways as well. The redefinition of the eligibility requirements for the University Opportunity Grant Program, which until 1976 was the main umbrella under which Black students were admitted, meant that some students who would have previously been eligible for those preferential need-based aid packages would no longer qualify for them. After 1976, the selection criteria for the Opportunity Program were changed so that only students with high school grade point averages and combined SAT scores below certain levels would be included in the program. The concern was that students of higher ability felt stigmatized by the "Opportunity" label. At the time the change was made, the higher ability students were not provided with a financial aid package comparable to that of the Opportunity Program students. An unintended effect of this change was to deny to academically more qualified minority students, however needy they might be, a substantial amount of gift aid that could have attracted them to or kept them in the University. In a situation where financial aid is critical to students' enrollment decisions, it seems safe to conclude that this change in financial aid policy had a negative effect on minority enrollment.

#### Other Factors Affecting Minority Enrollment

No doubt there are many other factors that have affected the minority enrollment trends reviewed here. Poor secondary school preparation is often cited as one reason. Although my paper demonstrates that there is a sufficiently large pool of qualified in-state minority students to increase our undergraduate enrollment significantly, it is a well known fact that Black students -- more than those from other minority groups -- are provided inferior educational opportunities at the Junior High and High School levels,

could be to attract at least a representative number of the state's Black or other minority high school graduates who go on to college.

The data show that Blacks, who over the past ten years have consistently constituted about ten percent of the state's college bound population, are greatly underrepresented at the University of Michigan. In 1982, for example, the University enrolled only 168 Black in-state freshmen, a mere 2.95% of the state's Black college-bound high school graduates; these 168 students constituted 5.5% of the University's in-state freshmen entrants. The other seriously underrepresented group at the University are the Native American students, who constituted slightly less than two percent of the state's college-bound seniors, but represented only .3 percent of UM's 1982 in-state freshmen. Hispanic students at the University are representative of their numbers in Michigan, but are far below their national college-bound rate.

Of the minority groups under consideration, only Asian students, who generally qualify for admission in large numbers, can be said to be well represented at the undergraduate level at the University. Of course, all minority groups are underrepresented in the Graduate School as well as in some other schools, departments, and programs.

#### Identifying the Pool of Qualified Underrepresented Minorities

Although certainly not all of the college-bound underrepresented minority students qualify for admission to the University of Michigan, 1984 data show that a considerable number of those students who do not apply show promise of success here. Recent data obtained from the American College Testing Service (ACT) by the Office of Admissions provided the basis for a study of the pool of minority high school seniors by the Office of Academic Planning & Analysis.

develops the specific skills reflected in aptitude examinations used in the admissions process. Various studies have shown that standardized tests are not good predictors of Black student performance in college. By giving more weight to high school records and teacher evaluations rather than to test scores (taking into account, of course, the quality of the high school and the nature of the student's course of study), it would appear that the University stands to gain significantly in the attempt to build up the numbers of under-represented minority students.

#### Recommendations

The University is making an active and concerted attempt to attract minority students, but still more intensive efforts are in order. The effort to increase minority enrollment should involve intervention at any or all of four different phases of the enrollment process: (1) the recruitment phase; (2) the admissions phase; (3) the enrollment decision phase; and (4) the retention to graduation phase.

#### A. Increasing the Applicant Pool

One of our first priorities must be to increase the proportion of under-represented minority students who apply to the University, with particular focus on students of demonstrated ability and promise, regardless of socioeconomic background. Several immediate steps may be taken in that effort, most of which would also affect the number of admitted students who actually enroll.

1. General efforts must be made to reach a larger number of minority students in recruiting, and to attempt a more personalized approach through

sity attempt, on an experimental basis, to increase the number of such students accepted (while assuring that a full range of ongoing support services is provided).

### C. Increasing the Yield Rate

It is also hoped that the University can increase the proportion of accepted minority students who enroll. In general, it is recommended that this goal be pursued through the provision of more information, more personalized attention, and more financial aid. Four specific foci are suggested as initial attempts to increase the yield rate.

1. In many respects, the active and personalized steps designed to increase the number of applications to the University should also help to increase its yield rate. Nevertheless, admissions is an ongoing process and additional steps can be taken at this stage. Personalized information and assistance -- to a degree that is unrealistic at earlier stages of the admissions process -- are in order here. (An example is the program to assure that phone calls from faculty members go to students who will receive Michigan Achievement Award (MAA) offers, advising them of the award.)
2. Financial aid is critical for minority students, many of whom come from lower income families. In 1982-83, for example, 65% of the University's dependent undergraduate minority aid recipients came from families with incomes of \$24,000 or less, while about 43% of the University's White aid recipients came from families in this economic group. For Opportunity Program students the contrast is even more marked; 75% come from families in this low income group. Modifications in present aid policies would

risk of enrolling elsewhere and suggest individually-specific responses to increase the probability of a student selecting Michigan.

#### D. Increasing Retention and Graduation Rates

A critical component to increased minority enrollment is the provision of services to increase retention and graduation rates. Although specific attention to this issue will require additional thought and study, and will be the subject of a later discussion paper, two points on the matter should be made at this juncture. First, the foregoing recommendations presume that careful attention to support services and other efforts to increase retention will be provided. In the absence of such efforts, our overall plan cannot be expected to succeed. Second, it might be noted that recommendations regarding changes in financial aid should assist efforts not only to influence application and enrollment decisions, but should also be expected to increase retention.

The Office of Financial Aid (OFA) has recognized that many minority students can benefit from personal financial counseling. OFA will soon augment its present efforts by having a counselor available on a part-time basis in the Opportunity Program/Comprehensive Studies Program Office. Additionally, OFA will make special efforts to contact minority students with hold credits and above average amounts of unmet need in order to provide financial counseling and assistance, where possible.

#### E. Ongoing Monitoring, Planning, and Administration

As was indicated earlier, continual monitoring of the policies and practices of this plan will be essential. It is recommended that an administrative and planning team be established and maintained to oversee the efforts to increase undergraduate minority enrollment.
